



## [Using Autodesk Bluestreak For Collaboration](#)

### Sign up for Bluestreak:

- Navigate to labs.autodesk.com
- Select the “Technology Previews Tab from the top of the page and select “Project Bluestreak AEC Collaboration”
- Click  >
- On the right side of the screen select  and create an account using an email account and creating a username.

### Create Bluestreak Profile

- Once you are signed up for Project Bluestreak, you may edit your profile and connect with other users to share projects and information.
- In order to may have to set up a group for your team or find your group if someone has already created one. This can be done by clicking “set up group” in the getting started window.
- You may also customize your page by uploading a personal picture for your profile if you choose.

### Collaborating via Project Bluestreak

- In order to collaborate in a group model using Bluestreak, you must install the Revit Activity Stream from the Autodesk app gallery. This can be accessed from the top of your Bluestreak profile. Hover your mouse over the “App” tab at the top of the screen and select “App Gallery” from the drop down menu.
- Select the activity stream for the specific version of Revit you are running on your computer.
- Next you must install the Bluestreak Desktop which is also available from the app gallery.
- When working from a central file in Revit after making changes from the Collaborate menu select “synchronize with central”
- A prompt will show up to sign in to Autodesk. Sign in using the username and password you created earlier. And Select “sign in”
- The changes you have made will show up on your project Bluestreak profile as well as in the groups you have created
